



## What is the Advanced Manufacturing Business Improvement Program?

The aim of the Advanced Manufacturing Quality Assurance Program is to support Tasmanian-based advanced manufacturing enterprises to undertake business improvements that will drive growth, efficiencies, competitiveness and enhance sustainability.

## What is available?

The program provides grants of up to a 50 per cent contribution towards business improvement activities subject to the applicant contributing at least 50 per cent of the project costs.

Maximum grant assistance is \$20 000. A total funding pool of \$150 000 is available in 2021-22, \$150 000 in 2022-23 and \$150 000 in 2023-24.

## Eligibility

The program is open to Tasmanian based advanced manufacturing enterprises with an annual sales turnover greater than \$300 000 and less than \$20 million. Eligible projects include advice on improving business sustainability, lean management, business, governance and succession reviews. To be eligible, project expenditure cannot be retrospective and cannot include costs such as capital expenditure, training expenses, salaries and wages, general operational expenditure.
