

The following has been released in relation to a request for information relating to the Tasman Bridge.

Overall, the bridge is in relatively good condition for a structure of its age and given its marine environment. Maintenance activities have included completion of all critical concrete and steel repairs and wrapping of all underwater piles. Currently planned activities are:
