submit this submission in support of **NOT** reducing our solar feed in tariff from 28.238c kWh to 8c kWh.

1. In 2013 we invested \$21000 +, and Aurora Energy costs to upgrade power boards for the installation of solar panels on 3 dwellings in Tasmania for ourselves and our two adult children to help them with rising costs of power prices.
2. This rebate helped enormously with skyrocketing power prices and reduced our children's and our own power bills to a manageable level.
3. If this reduction becomes legislated, we feel that we have been significantly disadvantaged regarding this investment. We did not have this money lying around, but needed to withdraw from our retirement investments.
4. We chose to make this investment due to the enormous amount of advertising re. Solar panel installation and rebate incentives at the time.
5. If this reduction does happen, we feel that our investment in Solar Energy will have been a waste of our hard earned money in our retirement fund. Leaving this money in our retirement fund would have been a better option over the last 5 years and into the future.
6. Please consider a fair and equitable feed in tariff of between 18c kWh to 20c kWh.
7. Due to the cost of installing solar batteries, this would now not be an option for us all.
