• The wording of the draft Authority closely matches the terms and conditions contained in permits normally issued by the Trust. This recognises the important role the Trust has with regard to the management of Wellington Park.

It will also help to ensure that the works carried out are managed consistently with regard to the protection of the Park's values and in accordance with the Wellington Park Management Plan 2013.

- The proponent must give the Minister and the Trust at least 5 business days' notice, in writing, prior to commencing "destructive authorised activities" as defined under the Authority, and 24 hours' notice for all other authorised activities.
- Authorised activities must be commenced within 21 days and completed within 60 days of the date of the original notice.
- All activities must be carried out in accordance with the information contained within the Authority, and all
  activities must be completed within two (2) years of the date of the Authority.

I understand that detailed discussion has already taken place at officer level between the Department of State Growth and the Trust, including a briefing by MWCC in which it outlined the intended works to the Trust's Manager, Mr Axel von Krusenstierna.

Thank you for your letter dated 15 February 2019 in which you provided comments on the draft Authority to enter land (Wellington Park).

I appreciate your explanation of the roles of the Wellington Park Management Trust (Trust) and Hobart City Council (Council) in the management of Wellington Park.

The Department of State Growth (the Department) has reviewed the draft Authority in response to your comments and to a large extent, has incorporated these in the Authority, a copy of which is attached.

I understand officers of the department recently met and consulted with the Manager of the Trust, Mr Axel von Krusenstierna, in relation to the revised draft Authority.

Further to this I would like to draw your attention to the following particular conditions within the Authority:

- The proponent must give the Minister, the Trust, and Council at least 5 business days' notice, in writing, prior to commencing "destructive authorised activities" as defined under the Authority.
- The abovementioned notice must include the precise location and nature of the destructive activities to be undertaken, the impact of each proposed activity and a record, including photographs, of the condition of the site prior to commencement of the proposed activities.
- The proponent must lodge with the Department a Safety Management Plan for the safety of members of the public in relation to authorised activities.
- The proponent must give 14 days' notice of any helicopter flights for transporting a drilling rig or other equipment.
- The proponent must give 24 hours' notice for all other authorised activities, including drone flights and must give notice of the actual commencement of all activities on the day of commencement.

- Authorised activities must be commenced within 21 days and completed within 60 days of the date of the original notice.
- The proponent must hold public liability insurance which indemnifies it against liability to other parties, including the Trust and Council.

Please note, Attachment I of the Authority has also been amended to include additional information provided by the Mount Wellington Cableway Company, namely:

- The use of temporary markers has been included in the Natural Zone Works Areas to facilitate marking of the envelopes for the tower in the Upper Area and an electricity line protection structure in the lower area.
- Within the Recreation Zone, specific marking of the proposed carpark area associated with the proposed terminal building, is now included.

The Authority now includes four annexures (Annexure C has been replaced with Annexures C1 and C2) in order to show Site C - Recreation Zone in higher resolution.

The Authority includes the capacity for me to appoint a person or persons to act as observers of the authorised activities, and officers from the Department will consult with the Trust in this regard.

In responding to the draft Authority, the Trust requested me to inform both it and Council of any time extensions, any changes to the authorised activities that require me to issue an amendment to the authority, as well as any unanticipated environmental or heritage discoveries reported by the proponent, which I am prepared to do. I will also provide the Trust with copies of reports provided to me on the work undertaken, once they are to my satisfaction.

Before I issue the authority, I would appreciate any further comments you may have in relation to the revised draft **Authority to enter land – Wellington Park**, within the next 5 working days.

MORE than 700 protesters are ready to be activated as peaceful defenders of kunanyi/Mount Wellington as the anticable car group earmarks six key locations across the city.

Respect the Mountain and Residents Opposed to the Cable Car have identified the Executive Building, 1+2 Architects, GHD Pty Ltd, North Barker Consulting, Brook St Pier and the Mount Wellington Cableway Company head office as prime locations for protests once the drilling works are given the tick of approval from State Growth Minister Peter Gutwein.

Respect the Mountain spokeswoman Louise Sales said those locations had been chosen specifically to hold those who support the cable car project to

"We think it's really disappointing they have chosen to support such a deeply divisive project," she said,

"We have more than 700 people signed up for peaceful action and that number is growing."

GHD Tasmania manager Sean Tucker last night said the company was not involved in the cable car project.

"We note the planned protests by

activists against the proposed cable car project are targeting the GHD office," he said.

While GHD did some preliminary site assessment work a number of years ago, we are not currently involved in the Mt Wellington Cable Car project at all."

Dozens of cable car opponents received training in direct action from the activists of the Bob Brown Foundation.

Ms Sales said another protest training session would be held on Tuesday. "We are keen for the protest to be peaceful," she said.

Residents Opposed to the Cable Car spokesman Ted Cutlan said people were angry and when the drilling started, it would manifest itself in protests across

the city. Independent candidate for Nelson and lawyer Richard Griggs, who supports peaceful protests, is concerned over the language used in Facebook posts from Respect the Mountain where it proposes to "undertake drilling operations at six business premises across the Hobart CBD"

I don't support the cable car but I also don't support anything even closely resembling violent protest or even references to violent protest," he said.
