### Reporting concerns and complaints

This includes reports of physical violence, sexual misconduct, sexual offences, grooming or other reportable conduct committed against, or in the presence of, children and young people.

\* Worker - a person who has attained the age of 18 years, who carries out work in any capacity for the department. This includes as an employee, volunteer, contractor, subcontractor, consultant, director, member of a management committee, office holder or officer.

\* Child - a person who has not attained the age of 18 years.

\* Young person (youth) - a person who has attained the age of 16 years but has not attained the age of 18 years.

The Department may also use the information for related purposes, or disclose it to third parties in circumstances allowed for by law.
