Axe falls on Phil

THE 2020 Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix, scheduled for October 25 at Phillip Island, has been cancelled because of the coronavirus restrictions.

The four-day MotoGP weekend attracts more than 85,000 spectators and generates about \$50 million each year.

The Australian Grand Prix Corporation and the sport's commercial rights holder Dorna made the call to cancel

the GP. The British Grand Prix, to be held on August 16 at Silverstone, has also been cancelled.

No races have been held yet this year, but Dorna plans to start in Europe in July.

Australian rider Jack Miller, who was in last year's race, was disappointed he was not able to race in front of his fans at the island.

"It's my favourite track of the whole year and the best circuit in the world," he said.
