I currently have 13 solar panels on my roof and have done since 2012 and obviously receiving 28.283 c/kWh.

So in relation to point - **9.Any other relevant matters that the person or group submitting would like to raise for consideration**; I need to raise the issue of my feed in rate being cut back to 8.541 c/kWh in January 2019.

If I am forced to receive 8.541 c/kWh then I shall have no choice but to go off grid, with a retro fitted battery system to enhance my existing system fitted in 2012.

8.541 c/kWh is no where near the compensation required for the initial financial cost to install my solar system.

I hope someone rethinks the short-sighted decision to cut back to 8.541 c/kWh in 2019, where is the incentive to continue supporting Tasmania's key power supplier.....?
