The South Hobart Progress Association (Inc.) (SHPA (Inc.), which is an associate of Planning Matters Alliance Tasmania (PMAT), wishes to support the very detailed submission by PMAT on the issue of **Tasmania's Population Strategy.**

Specifically, the SHPA (Inc.) considers that Tasmania should transition its economy from a reliance on continuous population growth towards an optimal, stable population to achieve the best possible **sustainable** social, environmental, cultural, economic outcomes for its people.

Further, the State Architect should be reinstated, and a policy to encourage and demand a high-quality of urban design.

The role of local councils should be mandated as "place shapers" underpinning community well-being and enriching our natural heritage, lifestyle and **democracy**.

Finally, there should be a moratorium on Government efforts to actively promote migration to Tasmania pending the provision of clear evidence demonstrating that population growth benefits individuals and communities; defines an optimal, sustainable population size for Tasmania; and provides evidence that a clear majority of Tasmanians support continuing population growth.
