The Background of Visiting	<p> In November 2014, when Lou Qinjian, then the governor of the government of Shaanxi Province visited Australia and signed <i>Tasmania Modern Agriculture (fruit) Industry Cooperation Memorandum</i> with Hodgman, the governor of Tasmania under the testimony of President Xi Jinping and Australian Prime Minister Abet, a exchange and cooperation platform between Shaanxi province and Tasmania has been built. In order to implement the contents of the memorandum, in 2015, the director general Gao Wubin has led the delegation of Shaanxi fruit industry to visit Australia, and had a technical communication with the Tasmanian Ministry of Basic Industry on the development of apple industry in Shaanxi and Tasmania. Discussion and consultation on the construction of apple industry schools and international apple demonstration garden have been held, too. From April 26 to 28, 2016, the Tasmanian Education Delegation of Australia has visited Shaanxi province. The delegation took part in the discussion with the Provincial Fruit Industry Bureau and visited the Luochuan Vocational Secondary Specialized School. This year, Shaanxi Provincial Fruit Industry </p>

Bureau is going to visit Australia to further implement the details of the cooperation between the Luochuan Vocational Secondary Specialized School and Tasmanian Higher Vocational and Technical Education College. Also, a cooperation agreement will be signed.

Visit the Tasmanian Fruit Growing Association to investigate the cultivation of fruits such as apple and cherry in Tasmania; to understand the inspection and quarantine requirements of Australian apple imports in order to better guide the export enterprises in Shaanxi province to monitor, prevent and improve orchard pests and diseases; help expert enterprises to register record information, improve management system, speed up the completion of technological transformation, upgrade production lines, and equipped factories with experimental equipment.

November 17th, 2014, Shaanxi Provincial People's Government and the State of Tasmania, Australia signed the "Shaanxi -Province Agriculture/Fruit Industry memorandum of cooperation."

Yangling Vocational and Technical College, Shaanxi Vocational and Technical College and other units.

(一)塔斯马尼亚高等职业教育学院、洛川县职业中等专业学校携手陕西职业技术学院、杨凌职业技术学院联合建立中澳(陕·塔)果业国际学校。

TasTAFE Vocational College collaborate with Luochuan County Vocational College, Shaanxi Vocational College and Yangling Vocational College to build Shaanxi-Tasmania Fruit Industry International School.

(二)采用联合办学形式,在塔斯马尼亚高等职业教育学院、洛川县职业中等专业学校分别挂牌成立中澳(陕·塔)果业国际学校。

By adopting the form of joint schools, TasTAFE College and Luochuan County Vocational College build campus of Shaanxi-Tasmania Fruit Industry International School in each side.

(三) 中澳(陕·塔)果业国际学校在陕每年招收英语达到四级或相当四级水平的大专以上毕业生 50—100 人学习果业技术; 每年对职业农民开展果业技术培训 500 人次。

The Shaanxi-Tasmania International Fruit Industry Institution recruits 50-100 university/college graduates, who reaches CET4 or equivalent English levels, to accept fruit industry technology education annually; recruits 500 occupational farmers to carry out the annual fruit industry technical training.

(四) 果业生产管理技术专业, 学制采用 2+1 形式(两年在洛川县职业中等专业学校, 一年在塔斯马尼亚高等职业教育学院)。学习完毕后获得澳洲认可的学历证书和技能等级证书, 塔方为有意向和符合条件的学生提供实习、就业机会。

The Fruit Production Technological Management subject impliments the teaching system of 2 + 1 model (two years in Luochuan County Vocational College and one year in TasTAFE College). After the course completed, the education certificates and skills certificates get recognized in Australia and Tasmania side

provide students who are interested and qualified with internships and employment opportunities.

TasTAFE Vocational College and Luochuan County Vocational College negotiate together to impliment related fruit production, technical management and personnel training program.

Luochuan County Vocational College organises outstanding graduates, teachers and professional growers to visit and study in TasTAFE Vocational College's fruit industry demonstration garden per year or semester

(七)塔斯马尼亚高等职业教育学院通过远程视频及来陕办讲座等形式，为陕西果农提供先进的管理理念、技术，果品营销准则和国际果业法规等培训。

TasTAFE Vocational College provides advanced management concepts, technologies , norms and international marketing of fruit fruit industry regulations training for farmers in Shaanxi through the

form of remote-education, conduct lectures in Shaanxi, ect.

(八)塔斯马尼亚高等职业教育学院定期为陕方派遣专家进行果树栽培技术、英文、贸易、物流配送、电子商务等专业培训。TasTAFE Vocational College dispatch technical experts in fruit cultivation, English, trade, distributions, e-commerce and other professional training to Shaanxi regularly.
