**Subject:** Tariff Review

You have now probably received a considerable amount of consumer input re the Domestic Solar Power Feed in Rate. However, the the disparity between the Domestic Solar Feed in Rate of 8.9 cents per Kw and the standard Tariff 31 rate which Aurora then on sells it ( at around 200% Plus profit) to the community remains the same. Totally obscene, and should be rectified immediately. I envisage a new Feed in Rate of between 20 to 24 cents would be totally acceptable. Also the Legacy rate should continue post 2018 if only for Age Pensioners in lieu of the above recommended Feed in Rate.

In addition to the foregoing, if Aurora continues to add a totally unreasonable Supply Charge to their monthly accounts, it follows that Solar Power producers should also be compensated by the government for annual expenses directly related to the maintenance of their systems.

Finally the Energy Regulator should be guided by his own conscience and not by State Government Pressure for dividends.
